

### Morning Prayer

Good Morning Heavenly Father and Precious Yeshua (Jesus). You are the Almighty God and Lord of Glory and my Friend. I am looking up, by faith, to the Holy of Holies of the Heavenly Sanctuary where you are ministering in behalf of poor, fallen humanity, and I seek a new perfect portion of Your love, grace and mercy for today. As You are well aware, Lord, my fallen nature is such that if left to myself, I will only produce all kinds of wicked deeds that would lead to my eternal destruction. Therefore, I cry unto You, Father, please appropriate to me, at his very moment, the merits of the blood Yeshua shed at Calvary for the forgiveness of my sins. I wish for You to mold me, fashion me, and raise me into a pure and holy atmosphere where the rich currents of Your sweet love may flow through my soul, and in turn bless those I encounter in this land of Your enemy. I gladly give my full consent for You, Dear Yeshua, to empty me of self today. Take my heart, for I cannot give it. It is Your property. Keep it pure, for I cannot keep it for You. Save me in spite of myself, my weak unchristlike self. I am overjoyed to consent today. I pray, Precious Redeemer, for You to cover me with Yeshua's righteousness and for Your Holy Spirit to rest upon me, and dwell in me this day. Please change me into Christ's likeness, as You've promised to do, when I behold You and Your son's life, character, and teachings this morning. And Dear Yeshua, please help me to spend quality, private time now, getting to know You better and becoming best friends with You and Your Father. I want to know Your voice and I pray that You can always say, I know (your name here) and he/she is my dear friend. I need You so much and I am humbled to know that You need me, too. I love You and please abide in me, Yeshua, and help me to trust you with everything today. Thank you, Father, for being attentive to my prayers. In the name of Your Son, Yeshua, and for His Name's sake I pray. Amen.

### Intercessory Prayer

Dear Heavenly Father, it is with a humble spirit of gratitude that I ask you to forgive the sins of \_\_\_\_\_ (name or names of people on your prayer list), and I ask by the Divine Authority of intercessory prayer for You, Father, to appropriate the merits of the Blood of Yeshua HaMachiach (Jesus Christ), Your Son, shed on Calvary for (name). I pray for the Holy Spirit of God to surround (name) with a Heavenly Atmosphere of Peace and Spiritual light so the rich currents of Your Love can flow through their soul(s) and they, too, will be covered with Yeshua's Righteousness. I pray to petition You, Father, to have your Holy Spirit overpower and nullify the power of sin in their lives. Give them a faith like Paul and his friends. Save them completely from self, from sin, from the world, and from the power of the fallen angels. Lead them by the Spirit of God to the City of God so that they never turn away from it. I now lift up their individual needs before Your throne and ask for the Holy Angels to be sent to minister and bless them according to Your Holy will. And please, Father, let them understand the importance of becoming best friends with You and Yeshua, and help them do it privately first thing every morning! Thank you! In Yeshua's Holy Name and to glorify his Name's sake, I pray. Amen.

### For Throughout the Day

It is my firm practice to never pray for a person or anything unless I raise my heart to God in this way first:

Dear Heavenly Father, in the Name of the Lord Yeshua, please forgive me if I have offended You in thought, word, or deed. I know, Lord that Your hand is not shortened that it cannot save, neither Your ear heavy that it cannot hear, but I realize that our iniquities and sins can separate us from You and Your blessings. (See Isaiah 59:1,2). I cannot afford to be separated from You even for a moment, so please make everything right between You and me, I pray, right now! Thank you, in Yeshua's Name, amen.

### Examples showing that prayer for others is more effective when we first ask God to forgive their sins.

- 1) Luke 23:34 – Yeshua could have forgiven them Himself but instead gave us this example.
- 2) Acts 7:59-60 – Stephen asking the Father to forgive his murderers.
- 3) Daniel 9:4-20 – Daniel prayed for himself and for all God's people (Israel). He was confessing their sins also and asking forgiveness for them, too.
- 4) Job 1:1-5 – "Burnt offering" is another way of saying "prayer". Note: it says in verse 5, by praying for their sins, he sanctified them! Sanctified means: made pure/Holy (forgiven)
- 5) Exodus 32:1-14 and v32 – Moses asks forgiveness for all the people and v14 God does it.
- 6) Nehemiah Chapter 1, especially see verses 6-11 – Nehemiah confesses the sins of all the children of Israel.

### Part of forgiveness if believing God that He totally forgives us! FAITH IN HIM!

When does the Bible say that it is essential to seek Yeshua? Our main focus is getting to know Him as our Friend. When do we need to do this according to the Bible and Yeshua's own example?

- 1) Proverbs 8:17 – He loves those who seek Him early.
- 2) Isaiah 50:4 – Jehovah promises to even wake you to hear his word.
- 3) Mark 1:35 – Yeshua's example
- 4) Exodus 16:4 & 21 – What does the bread (manna) represent? Yeshua! (See number five.)
- 5) John 6:48-51 – Yeshua is the Bread of Life!
- 6) Job 1:5 – Job prayed early in the morning.
- 7) Matthew 6:6 – private prayer

If you do this every morning, you will know Yeshua and knowing Him is eternal life! John 17:3. John Chapter 17 is the prayer of Yeshua. Read especially verse 20-26.

Philemon 3:8, 10 – Knowledge of Him, know Him! Nahum 1:7 – a refuge in time of trouble

What is the opposite? Matthew 7:23. Sin = not knowing Him. See also 2 Thessalonians 1:7-8, Matthew 25:12, 1 John 3:6

James 4:2-3 – you do not have because you do not ask. Matthew 7:7 – knock, seek find. Be persistent!
