

How to watch for the second coming:

God told the plan of human redemption in his holy days, laid out in Leviticus 23. When Yahshua (Jesus) came the first time, he fulfilled the spring feasts to the very minute in time, and to the very purpose in meaning. He was the Passover lamb, to take away the sin of the world, and he was crucified on the date of the Passover offering. He rose on the day of Firstfruits, and was the Firstfruit offering in heaven. He nailed the record of our sin to his cross, as our unleavened Bread of Life. His Holy Spirit descended on his people on the day of Pentecost.

Now we await his second coming. The fall feasts lay out the meaning, and most likely the time, behind the events of the second coming.

Yom Teruah (Day of Trumpets) - the final warning call to come out of Babylon. Are you in Babylon? Look on the back of this page to see if you are following the Scriptural way of the Son of God, or if you have inherited lies (Jeremiah 16:19) and are unwittingly following the pagan sun god.

Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement) - the time of the pronouncement in Revelation 22:11: "He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he which is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still." Those who failed to heed the call to come out of Babylon will be eternally lost on the final Day of Atonement.

Sukkot (Feast of Tabernacles) - the original purpose of the tabernacle in the time of Moses was so that YHVH could dwell among us. (Exodus 25:8) The final fulfillment of Tabernacles will be when we begin to dwell with our Creator for eternity. (Revelation 21:22)

Now do you see why satan has blinded our eyes to God's holy days? It is the anti-christ who THINKS to change God's holy times (Daniel 7:25). But God assures us that he changes not (Malachi 3:6, Psalm 89:34), so we can be assured that his calendar is still in effect. If we love him, let's obey him, and learn to watch for his soon return. (Exodus 20:6; John 14:15, 23; John 15:10; 1 John 5:2-3)

ANNUAL SABBATHS, THEIR MEANINGS, AND THEIR LINK TO REVELATION

Holy Day	Meaning	Revelation Chapters
Passover	Need for a Saviour	1 and 4-5: We meet the Lamb
Unleavened Bread	Need to remove sin from our lives	2-3: Church coming out of sin
Pentecost	Need for the Holy Spirit	6-7: Sealing of the 144,000
Trumpets	Last call to come out of Babylon	8-11: Trumpets
Day of Atonement	Final opportunity to purge sin from our lives	12-15: Probation closes
Tabernacles (1st day)	Preparing to meet our Redeemer	19-20: Second Coming
Tabernacles Great Feast (8th day)	Marriage supper with the Lamb	21: New earth

If you believe that we should acknowledge our need of a Saviour, remove sin from our lives, be filled with the Holy Spirit, come out of Babylon, purge our lives of sin, and prepare to meet our Redeemer, then you can see that the meaning of these annual days is still significant for God's church.

Just like satan has a counterfeit to the 7th day Sabbath, he has a counterfeit to the annual Sabbaths. Prayerfully keep the Biblical Holy Days, rather than the pagan holidays, (like Sunday, Easter and Christmas) this season. God's way is always better!!!
